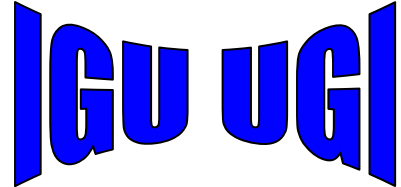

The Local Organizing Committee of the International Colloquium of the IGU CSRS is pleased to send you this first invitation as well as the presentation of the colloquium and its main topic.

You are invited to participate actively in the workshops and round-tables planned for this colloquium. This international gathering will be held at the Faculté des Lettres et des Sciences Humaines, Université Mohammed V-Agdal, Rabat (Morocco) from **July 9th to 15th 2007**. The organization of the colloquium is being coordinated in close collaboration with the IGU Commission on the Sustainability of Rural Systems..

This Colloquium is organized around a week of activities, including:

Three days of scientific exchanges and communications (paper sessions, round tables and workshops based on selected themes)

Registration Fees (per person and per couple)

--**700 Euros per person.** The first installment (50%) is due on the 31st January 2007. The second and final installment (50%) before May 31st , 2007.

This amount covers lodging, food, documentation for the colloquium and the field-trip costs inside Morocco.

--**1050 Euros per couple**

NB : Young researchers from countries from the South who wish to participate by giving papers, and who cannot afford registration fees for the colloquium should send a request to the Local Organizing Committee who will try to apply for a grant on their behalf through different partners.
